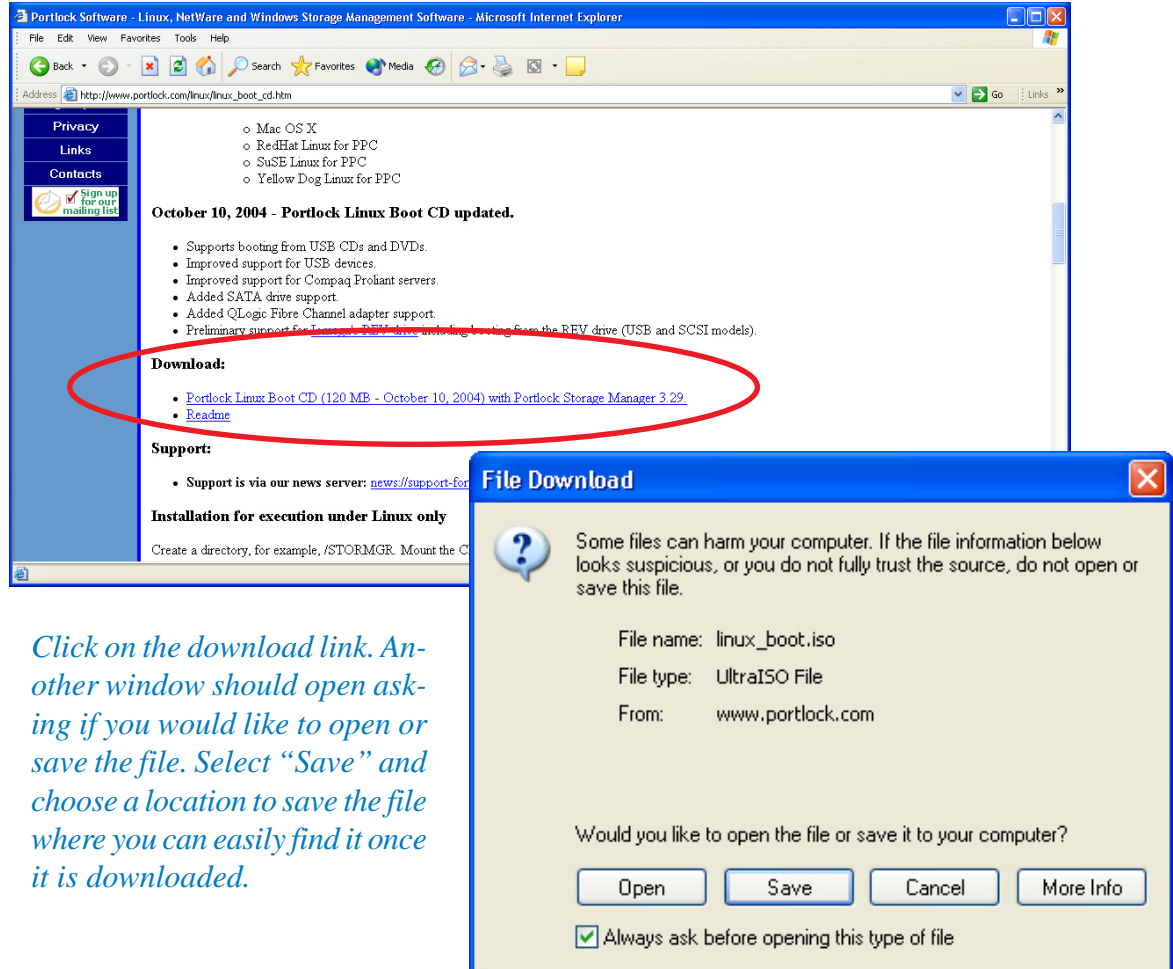


### Replacing license files in the Portlock Linux Boot CD

First, download the most current version of the Linux Boot CD ISO image. This can be found at [http://www.portlock.com/linux/linux\\_boot\\_cd.htm](http://www.portlock.com/linux/linux_boot_cd.htm)



*Click on the download link. Another window should open asking if you would like to open or save the file. Select "Save" and choose a location to save the file where you can easily find it once it is downloaded.*

Unzip the compressed file containing your production license. Save the .lic file to an easily accessed location.

In order to modify the CD ISO image file and replace licenses, you will need a product such as UltraISO or MagicISO that allows direct editing of the ISO image. These products are available for download at:

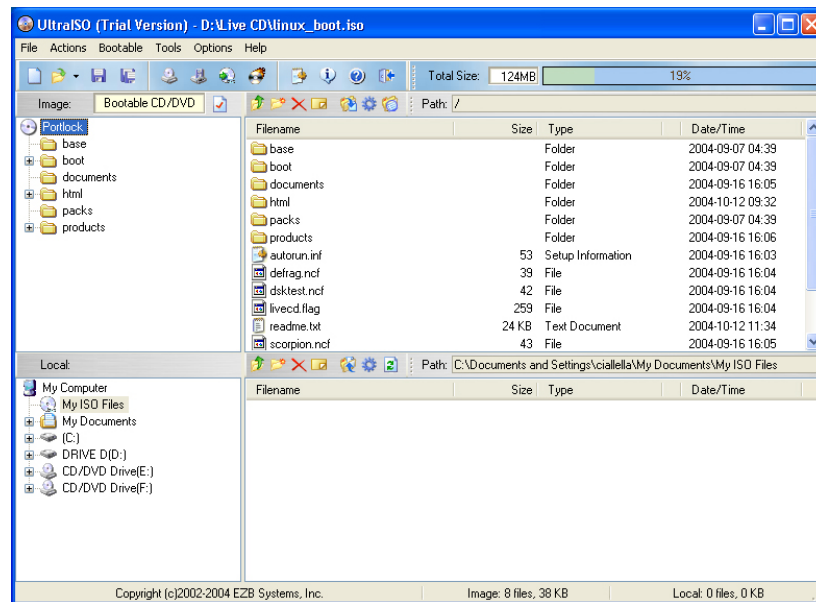
**MagicISO:** <http://www.magiciso.com>

*Install one of these products.*

**NOTE:** An occasional anomaly has been experienced when using MagicISO version 4.6 (build 0124) in which MagicISO fails to completely save the new ISO image by approximately 50 kb. If this occurs, the newly burned CD will not boot.

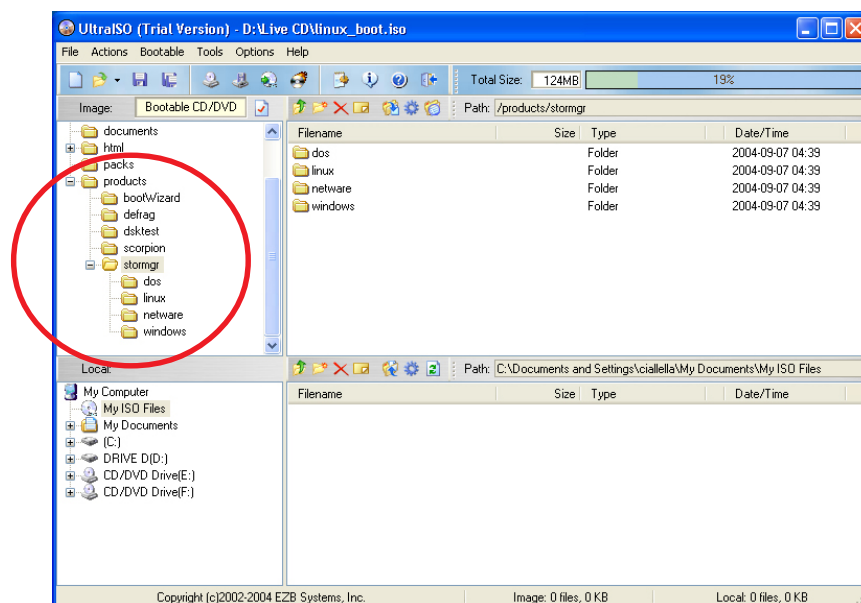
Open the iso image you downloaded from Portlock using the File/Open menu item in UltraISO or MagicISO.

In the directory tree, you will see a “products” subdirectory.

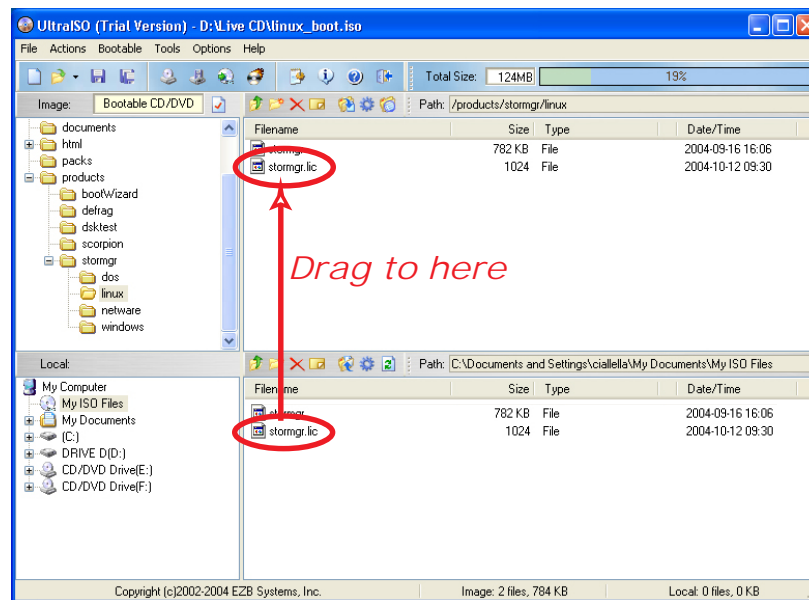


Open it and you will see a subdirectory for each product.

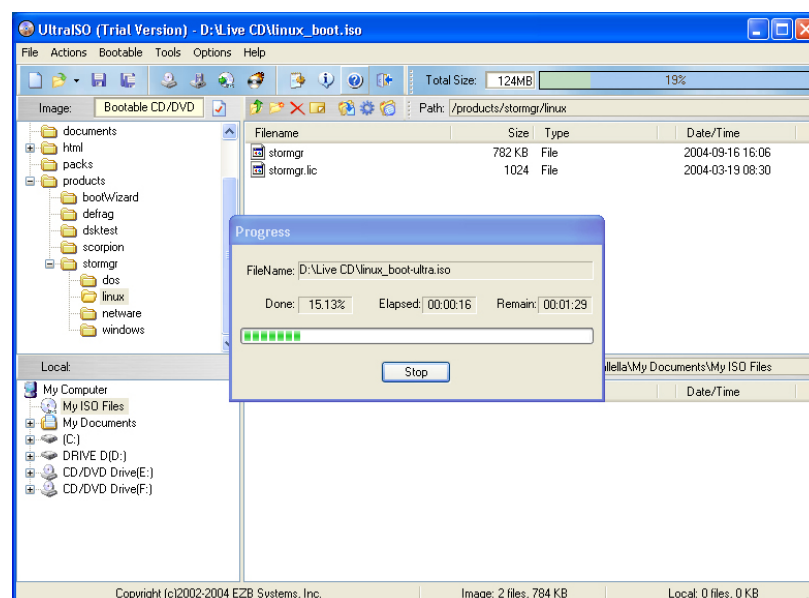
You will note that the “stormgr” subdirectory is further divided into DOS, Linux, NetWare, and Windows subdirectories. Select the subdirectory of the product in which you wish to update the license, with the exception of the Windows subdirectory under “stormgr” which holds a self-contained installer.



You may then replace the “product”.lic file by choosing your replacement license and dragging it over the old license.



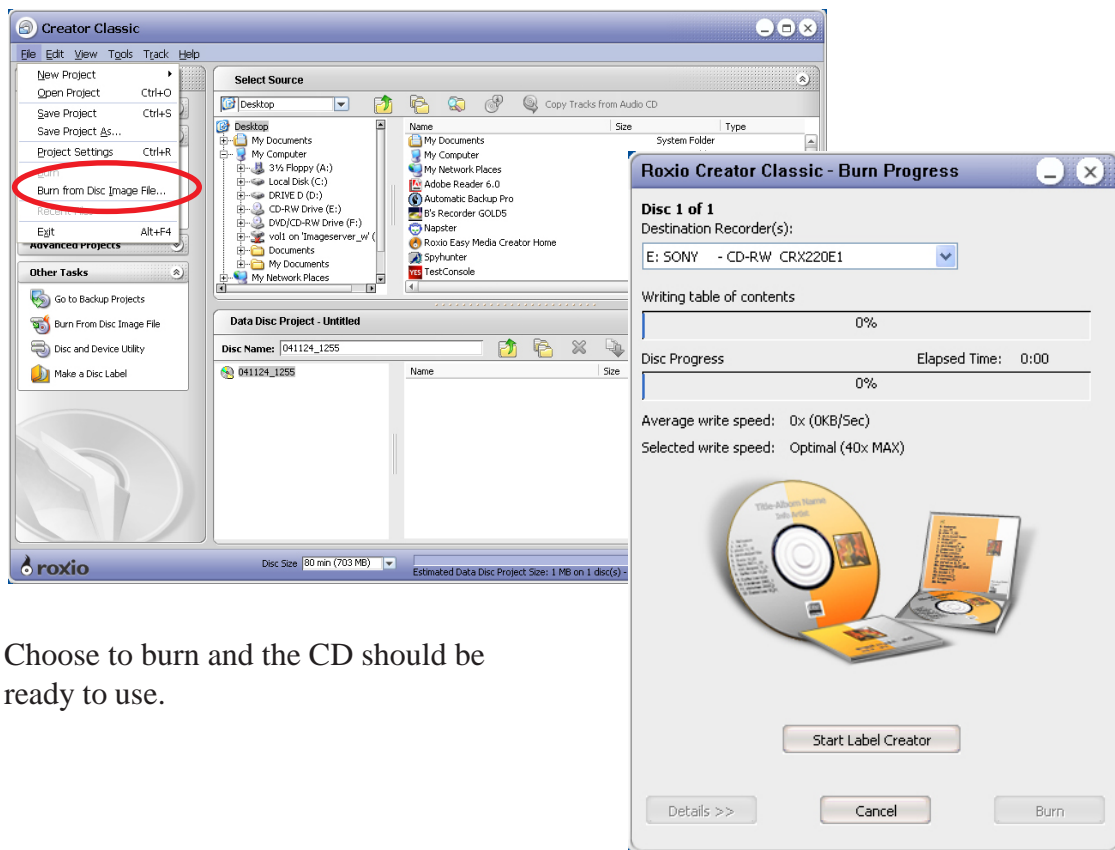
Save the modified ISO file and burn a new copy of the Boot CD with it.



**NOTE:** You can replace the windows setup.exe file in a like manner. Also note that “BootWizard” does not require a license.

## *Using Roxio Creator Classic to burn the ISO Image*

Open Roxio Creator Classic (I use version 7.0). Under the Tasks column on the left-hand side of the page, select the “Other Tasks” category and choose the “Burn From Disc Image File” task. (In older versions, this is found under the “File” menu item.) Use the explorer file selector to choose your downloaded ISO image file.



Choose to burn and the CD should be ready to use.

**NOTE:** These instructions are given using Roxio Creator Classic. Other CD burning software can be used. CD burning software is available from these websites:
